- 1. Give the names of the three most important characters and a brief description of each (age, personality, physical description, relationships to other characters). Describe how the characters are like or not alike you
- 2. Identify the setting of the book. Be sure to identify all important times and places. Compare the setting to your current hometown.
- 3. Identify the main problem faced by the characters in the book. Have you experienced similar problems? How is the problem solved or resolved?
- 4. Could the story have ended differently? How would you have liked it to end?
- 5. Write a paragraph telling something you have seen or experienced that is similar to an event in the story.
- 6. Select an event from the book that you thought was interesting. Give at least three reasons why you liked it.
- 7. How might the story have been different from another character's point of view?
- 8. Did you expect the story to end the way it did? What clues did the author give as to how it would end?
