Write the title of the book and the author at the top of the page and answer the questions using complete sentences! You should have at least 3 sentences per question.

1. Give the names of the three most important characters and a brief description of each (age, personality, physical description, relationships to other characters). Describe how the characters are like or not alike you
2. Identify the setting of the book. Be sure to identify all important times and places. Compare the setting to your current hometown.
3. Identify the main problem faced by the characters in the book. Have you experienced similar problems? How is the problem solved or resolved?
4. Could the story have ended differently? How would you have liked it to end?
5. Write a paragraph telling something you have seen or experienced that is similar to an event in the story.
6. Select an event from the book that you thought was interesting. Give at least three reasons why you liked it.
7. How might the story have been different from another character's point of view?
8. Did you expect the story to end the way it did? What clues did the author give as to how it would end?
